

When air quality is bad

Check the pollution level (AQI) at airnow.gov or www2.purpleair.com.

Your home gets filtered fresh air from a central fan serving the whole building. The air filter cleans most pollution, but it may struggle on very hazardous days. If you are concerned about air quality, ask property management how they plan to manage severely hazardous pollution.

When the weather is hot

Your home has built-in heaters, but no active air conditioning system. Take these steps to stay comfortable.

If needed, ask property management about nearby cooling centers or options for refrigerating critical medications.
