

PROJECT THE FRED CODY BUILDING + CODY'S CAFE

The Fred Cody Building is a new three-story building with a retail storefront, Cody's Books receiving area, additional sales area for the bookstore, greenhouse flower stand, and office spaces on the second and third floors. The café with its 22-foot ceiling is set behind a large, curving glass bay. Windows open to the outdoors and to the adjacent namesake bookstore. This double-height space is interrupted by a curving white mezzanine with additional seating.
